

FONTHILL OLD ABBEY, WILTSHIRE

Coordination/production of a Design and Access/Heritage Statement to gain planning permission for a new Estate dwelling to be built alongside a Grade II listed 18th Century folly.



Fonthill Abbey is a large folly building constructed in the 18th Century. The remaining Grade II Listed tower, with Victorian extension gained planning permission to have a new Estate dwelling built alongside – with MLA successfully having coordinated the Design and Access / Heritage Statement and led negotiations with both Wiltshire Council and English Heritage.
